Maple Ridge Homeowners Association Mailbox Maintenance Guidelines and Suggestions

- Flags should be straightened and replaced if damaged
- Numbers should be replaced if missing. Contact TSG at management@totalservicegroupllc.com for a stock replacement number from the original mailbox supplier
- The mailbox portion is a standard size and color available form Lowes or Home Depot. If you are handy you will need to line up the number holder and drill 2 holes in the top to fasten it to the new mailbox.
- Replacement parts can be ordered from the original supplier at https://addressesofdistinction.com
- Straighten leaning mailboxes
- Trim out of control vines or weeds around or growing on your mailbox
- Suggestions for cleaning and painting a dull or faded mailbox:
 - 1. Wash with a mild detergent or car wash solution
 - 2. Sand any peeling, stubborn stains, or rust
 - 3. Use a gloss black, good quality spray paint. Several owners suggest gloss black engine paint for a durable finish. Be careful to avoid overspray on your car or neighbor's property!
 - 4. If your numbers are darkened and are not legible, try a solvent to clean them and restore their luster by using an extra fine sand paper or steel wool.
 - 5. Install black colored bird mailbox protection spikes to discourage birds from using the top as their favorite depository.
