Josie's Outlaws is the organization set up to raise the funds for various Down Syndrome projects, including Gigi's Playhouse. Josie's Outlaws for Down Syndrome was founded after its namesake, Josie Grace Kent, was born with Down Syndrome. Today Josie is an active and joyful little girl who has not let Down Syndrome slow her down by a single step! Josie's unique story has been featured on multiple media platforms including film and radio, making her somewhat of a pint-sized celebrity. Josie's Outlaws' goal is to bring a Gigi's Playhouse to Columbus to serve West Central GA and East Central Alabama. Gigi's Playhouse provides free educational, therapeutic-based, and career development programs for individuals with Down syndrome, their families, and the community, through a replicable playhouse model. It is a Down Syndrome Achievement Center. There are only 2 locations in GA, both in the ATL area and zero locations in Alabama. There are over 58 locations across the US and Mexico. Gigi's Playhouse is a non-profit 501(c)(3). To be considered for a Playhouse, an initial \$10,000 must be raised.

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
